Introducing a new league for new curlers

Do you have friends, co-workers or family members who are interested in trying out the great sport of curling? For the final six weeks of the season, you are invited to bring them out to the club for our "New Curler Leagues".

There are two options – Mondays or Tuesdays – with four teams able to play each night for a six-game schedule. The Tuesday night league will run Feb 14 to March 20, and the Monday night league will run Feb. 20 to March 26. Each night will include practice starting at 7 pm, followed by a six-end game.

Cost is \$50 per new player, and a current member is encouraged to act as mentor for each team. A team should consist of three new curlers and a mentor. If you are interested in entering a team or being a mentor contact Dale or Cheryl in the DCCC office to get your team registered.
